Forged from the legacy of TPANs "Ride for Life Chicago", The Victory Lap Chicago is a reinvigorated and reimagined movement based fundraising event-- a mission critical to the life empowering work of TPAN and its community leaders.

For more than 15 years, RFLC served as the vehicle of support for TPANs delivery of healthcare and services to people living with HIV/AIDS and related health conditions.

Victory Lap continues on this legacy, as a celebration of where TPANs triumphant impact on Chicago and expansion of who we serve. The Victory Lap will bring together thousands of donors and hundreds of volunteers, participants and advocates to ensure that nearly 2,000 people per year have access to TPANs care and services at no cost.

Through the commitment to move along the physical and virtual 25-100 mile course, participants and volunteers will share their stories of triumph over HIV, their commitment to end HIV/AIDS and TPANs success in providing expert, compassionate health services to individuals and families across Chicago.


ROAD TO VICTORY

The Road to Victory will consist of community based, grassroots events that lead up to our triumphant lap. This will include training for our centennial movers, team fundraisers, and morale centered events.




THE VICTORY LAP

The **Victory Lap** will be a Chicago based movement consisting of a 25 Mile main course that can be lapped up to a 100 Mile Centurty course. The movement can be traveled physically or virtually.

As treatment for HIV has improved, and people living with HIV who take their medications are living longer, TPAN's work has expanded.

While HIV is a common concern for our clients, it is not the only issue we address. Today, almost 30% of those who visit TPAN are unstably housed, and many are coping with mental health or substance use issues. The average client has an annual household income of \$15,000. TPAN's free services address co-occurring conditions faced by HIV-positive and vulnerable individuals—HIV stigma, mental illness, substance abuse, homelessness, unemployment, extreme poverty and inadequate access to healthcare. We are committed to meeting our clients' needs, whatever they may be.
