



Job Posting Mental Health Therapist

According to the organization's overall needs and under the direction of the Mental Health Program Manager, the Mental Health Therapist shall conduct mental health assessments and client enrollment intakes, maintain confidential client records, conduct individual counseling sessions, and facilitate a group.

Principal Responsibilities:

1. Conduct comprehensive mental health assessments, develop treatment plans, assess and diagnose clients, and provide individual counseling sessions for a caseload of approximately 20 clients.
2. Maintain required records, files, and forms in an organized manner and per HIPAA and other State, Local, and Federal Guidelines
3. Participate in staff meetings and complete necessary trainings.
4. Gather, process, analyze, and report program data.
5. Regular and predictable attendance is required and must be able to work extended hours, including mornings and evenings, according to the demands of the role
6. Other related duties as assigned by the Mental Health Program Manager

Specific Position Requirements:

- Masters degree with experience in Social Work, Psychology, Public Health, or related field
- Possess an LCPC or LCSW. No exceptions.
- Minimum of 1 year of experience working with individuals living with HIV
- Minimum of 3 years working as a licensed clinician.
- Strong interpersonal, organizational, and written and verbal communication skills
- Strong critical thinking and reasoning skills
- Demonstrated cultural competence in working with people of color, the LGBTQ community, and aging adults, as well as experience and knowledge working with those living with and affected by HIV/AIDS
