Guest speaker for the evening is **Peter Staley**, an early member of ACT UP, a direct action advocacy group formed in the late 1980s. ACT UP was instrumental in getting greater access to experimental AIDS drugs and for the creation of a coordinated national policy to fight the disease. The event is expected to attract upwards of 350 guests, including local luminaries and public officials.


Our staff works with a broad range of diverse clients from all walks of life. TPAN clients range in age from 18 to over 65.


CLIENTS BY AGE


CLIENTS BY RACE

CLIENTS BY SEXUAL ORIENTATION


Men who have sex with men	80%
