WHO WE SERVE

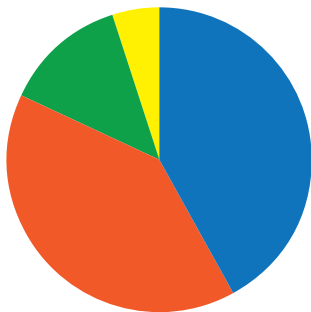
Our staff works with a broad range of diverse clients from all walks of life. TPAN clients range in age from 18 to over 65.

Many of the people who walk through our doors face significant economic challenges that make accessing care more difficult.

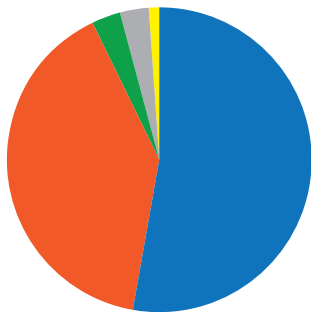
CLIENTS BY AGE

65 and over	5%



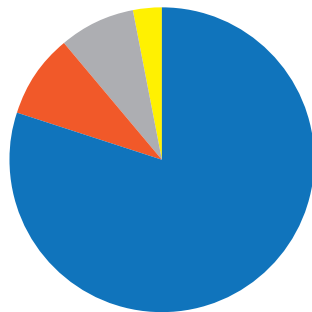
CLIENTS BY RACE
